The Petition to Compel Arbitration of petitioner Total Transportation Services, Inc. came on for hearing before this Court on December 4, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. before the Honorable Ross M. Klein. After full consideration of this matter and all documents, briefing, pleading, evidence and argument filed with the Court or presented at the hearing, the Court finds as follows:

- 1. Petitioner Total Transportation Services, Inc. cannot compel arbitration under the Federal Arbitration Act (FAA), 9 U.S.C. § 1 *et seq.*, because the individual respondents are transportation workers exempted from the FAA.
- 2. The arbitration agreements under which Petitioner Total Transportation Services, Inc. seeks to compel arbitration do not require arbitration of statutory wage claims filed with the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement.
- 3. Petitioner Total Transportation Services, Inc. cannot compel arbitration under the California Arbitration Act (CAA), Cal. Code Civ. Proc. § 1280 et seq., because the waiver of the right to file statutory wage claims with the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement is contrary to state policy and unenforceable.
- 4. Pursuant to California Labor Code § 229, Petitioner Total Transportation Services, Inc. cannot compel arbitration of Respondents' claims for unpaid wages.
- 5. The arbitration agreements under which Petitioner Total Transportation Services, Inc. seeks to compel arbitration are procedurally and substantively unconscionable and cannot be enforced against respondents.
- 6. Petitioner Total Transportation Services, Inc. has waived its right to seek arbitration of the Court in corporates of under the agreements it seeks to enforce in this action. Fullings on the endentiary
