ORDER DENYING REDACTIONS

On March 16, 2022, the Court issued a sealed order denying Defendant's motion for summary judgment and giving the parties 15 days to propose redactions for a publicly available version of the Order. (Doc. No. 184.) Plaintiffs submit that no redactions are necessary. (Doc. No. 186.) After initially not responding, Defendants now seek to redact the names of school district staff members who are not parties to the case under the Minnesota Data Practices Act, Minn. Stat. § 13.43 (Doc. No. 190.) Both parties filed additional letters detailing their respective positions. (Doc. Nos. 192, 193.) The Court has carefully considered the parties' arguments and concludes that there is no basis for redacting the names of the school district staff members. Accordingly, the Court issues the following **ORDER**:

1. Defendant's Request for Redaction to ECF No. 184 Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13.43 (Doc. No. [190]) is respectfully **DENIED**.
2. The Court directs the Clerk's Office to lift all restrictions to the Order filed on March 16, 2022 (Doc. No. [184]) and to make it publicly available without redactions.
