DECLARATION OF GERARDO CAMPOS

- ① MY NAME IS GERARDO CAMPOS. I AM 26-YEAR-OLD I AM FROM LOS ANGELES
- ② TODAY IS SUNDAY I WAS ARRESTED ON WEDNESDAY, NOV. 9TH. I HAVE BEEN IN JAIL EVER SINCE BECAUSE I CANNOT AFFORD TO PAY BAIL.
- ③ MY BAIL IS SET AT \$70,000. I CANNOT AFFORD TO PAY. IF I COULD PAY, I WOULD SO THAT I COULD GET OUT RIGHT AWAY.
- ④ I DON'T HAVE ANY FRIENDS OR FAMILY WHO COULD PAY BAIL FOR ME AND I CAN'T AFFORD TO PAY A BONDSMAN. THEY CAN'T EITHER.
- ⑤ I WAS GIVEN A PINK PIECE OF PAPER WITH MY BAIL AMOUNT, BUT I LOST IT.
- ⑥ NO ONE TOLD ME WHY MY BAIL WAS SET AT THAT AMOUNT. I DON'T KNOW WHO DECIDED THAT OR HOW.
- ⑦ I AM NOT AWARE OF ANY OTHER OPTIONS

⑥ I HAVE NOT SEEN OR SPOKEN WITH ANY JUDGE OR MAGISTRATE ABOUT MY INABILITY TO PAY BAIL. NO ONE ELSE HAS DONE SO ON MY BEHALF.

⑦ I CANNOT AFFORD TO HIRE AN ATTORNEY AND I HAVE NOT BEEN ASSIGNED ONE.

⑧ NO ONE FROM THE PROBATION DEPT HAS INTERVIEWED ME ABOUT MY INABILITY TO PAY BAIL OR HOW ELSE I CAN GET OUT OF JAIL.

⑨ I AM UNHOUSED AND HAVE NOT HAD A STABLE PLACE TO LIVE SINCE HIGH SCHOOL MIDDLE

⑩ I RELY ON MY FRIENDS TO SURVIVE. THEY LET ME SLEEP IN THEIR HOUSES AND SLEEP IN THEIR CARS.

⑪ I FEEL HARD TO KEEP MYSELF GROOMED BECAUSE PEOPLE DON'T TREAT YOU WELL IF YOU LOOK HOMELESS.

⑫ BUT IT IS A STRUGGLE TO GET ENOUGH FOOD WATER, AND TO TAKE CARE OF MY OTHER EVERYDAY NECESSITIES

14 I RECENTLY TRIED TO GET INTO A SHELTER BUT WHEN I SHOWED UP I WAS TOLD THEY'RE ALL FULL NO VACANCIES WHATSOEVER.

15 I WORK GENERAL CONSTRUCTION AS OFTEN AS I CAN TO GET BY, BUT MY WORK OPPORTUNITIES ARE UNSTABLE AND HARD TO PREDICT.

16 MY PARENTS KNOW I'M A TOUGH COOKIE BUT THEY WANT THE BEST FOR ME AND WANT ME TO BE HONEST.


17 EVERY DAY I'M IN JAIL THAT'S ONE DAY OF POTENTIAL WAGES I AM LOSING.
